Participation in the organization's programs is subject to the observance of the organization's rules and procedures. *The activities outlined below are strictly prohibited.* Any participant, AmeriCorps National Service Member, volunteer or staff member who violates this Code is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the program.

- Abusive language towards a staff member, volunteer or participant
- Any infraction of Nevada Outdoor School's Drug-Free Workplace Policy
- Bringing onto Nevada Outdoor School's property dangerous or unauthorized materials such as explosives, firearms, lethal weapons or other similar items
- Discourtesy or rudeness to a participant, staff member or volunteer
- Verbal, physical or visual harassment of a participant, staff member or volunteer
- Actual or threatened violence toward any individual or group
- Conduct endangering the life, safety, health or well-being of others
- Bullying or taking unfair advantage of any participant, staff member or volunteer
- Sexual harassment or assault on any participant, staff member or volunteer
- Perjury or fraudulent information on your applications
- Regular tardiness to work or organized events
- Harmful actions against the organization i.e. speaking badly about the organization, stealing or working against its mission
- Conviction of criminal offenses
- Misuse of computers/internet i.e. downloading adult content
- Regular inattention to requested tasks and timelines
- Any other violations of NOS policies and procedures not listed here
